## Abstract

'www Research Project' is a project aiming to investigate further into the 453 vessels, identified as having wrecked on or around the Sarn Badrig Reef that have been compiled during the research lead between 2001-2009 on the *Diamond*, a Welsh designated site, through on-line research.

My objective is to collect and report any information available on-line about one of the 453 vessels, called Phoebe, which has been reported in the MADU data-base (MADU ref.93) as a schooner built in Newport in 1839, and having sank on 14<sup>th</sup> January 1843.

The schooner Phoebe seemed to have enough information to start with a base but not too much so still be able to discover and report new data. It was hoped through the research to be able to answer the following questions:

- What historical information is available relating to the vessel?
- What caused the wrecking?
- Were there any survivors?
- Are there any testimonies available from the time?
- What has happened since the wrecking?
- Has anyone previously investigated or researched the vessel back story?
- Has anyone dived, recorded, surveyed or worked on the site?

## Research Methodology

Research was done in August 2020 during quarantine restrictions, and by consequences limited to online resources. The research was conducted on a MacBook Air, operating system: macOS Catalina, and internet browsers: Safari.

The first steps were to check out the recommended websites given on the www – Research Guidance notes such as: Lloyds Register entries, wrecksite, and Coflein. From the wrecksite, I contacted Tom Bennett and Levano Hervé, who directed me to different articles from the British Newspaper Archive and the newspaperarchive.

General searches were conducted through Google and Ecosia searches such as 'Phoebe schooner', 'Phoebe 1839 Pembrokeshire', 'David Havard Phoebe Pembrokeshire', etc.

The hurricane that caused the wrecking of the Phoebe, caused the loss of some other 180 ships in England and Northern France.

David Havard was Captain on the Phoebe when it wrecked, and partly owner. He came from West street Newport, Pembrokeshire, Wales. He died during the wrecking of the Phoebe aged 41. The gravestone commemorating him is at St Mary's Church churchyard, Newport, Pembrokeshire, Wales.

## Analysis

The British Newspaper Archive provided a lot of sources concerning the Phoebe, however many of them repeated itself. The Havard papers would have probably provided me with more information concerning the building of the ship and any other information relating specifically the ship, such as its measurements. Not being a UK citizen, I unfortunately could not access those. Future researchers of the Phoebe should investigate those papers (<https://archives.library.wales/index.php/printed-miscellanea-8>), in addition to Glen Johnson's list to see if the Phoebe has been added to it (<http://www.glen-johnson.co.uk/cardigan-st-dogmaels-ships-and-captains/>).

## Conclusions & Recommendations

Five hours were approximately spent researching about the Phoebe. Some further online research might be interesting to do, just in case something was missed, or any information has been added anywhere. The ship itself was highly damaged and anything that could be saved was, therefore any exploratory dive would not be highly useful. The exact wrecksite has not been located, but the schooner wrecked three miles North of Aberdovey.

Most of the questions initially asked have been answered, but as during the research the same information was made available again and again, I believe that we do not have the materials to answer all of them in more depth.
